We will continue to send home phonics cards so please use these at home with your children, Five minutes practise a day really does make all the difference.



**Reading books** A new system is being introduced across the whole school at the beginning of term 2. Further details will be sent out by Mrs Lewis and Miss Cox.

Each class will also be visiting the library in term 2 and we will need helpers to walk there and back. You do not need a DBS for this.



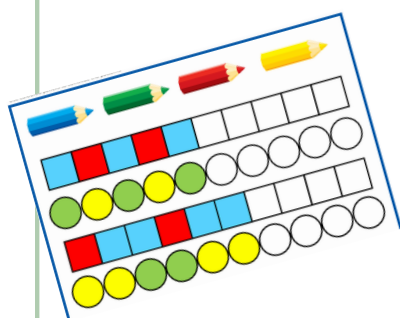
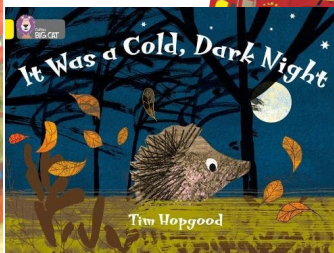
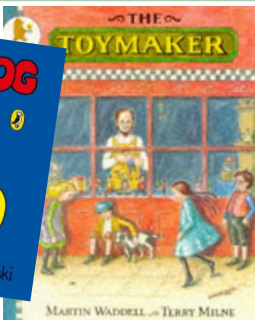
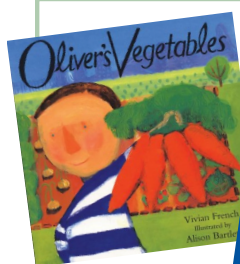
## Holiday Project
