Learning at Home

Phonics and reading - Thank you for all your support with the new reading scheme, it is working really well and making a huge difference to the children's reading and comprehension skills. Please do continue to read regularly at home, and don't forget to sign your child's diary! Reading regularly is crucial for children at this stage of development. We have now finished learning all phase 2 and 3 sounds but continue to practice these with your child at home. We are now working on revisiting and reviewing all phase 3 sounds and using this knowledge when reading longer words.



We have now sent all phonics cards home but if you have mislaid a few or would like some extra then please do let us know!

Reading books - Hopefully everyone is now in the swing with the new reading packs which have been sent home since the beginning of term 2. Please continue to read these books with the children 3 x a week and record this in their reading diary, alongside other books your child is bringing home. Please remember to return these books weekly as we only have limited copies of each book!

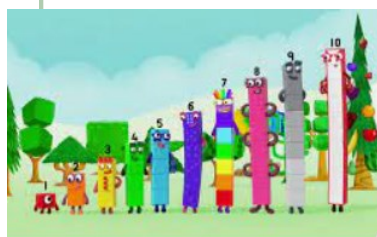
