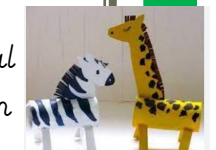

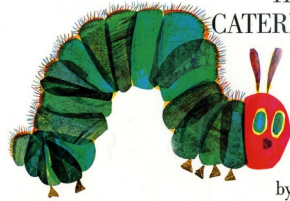
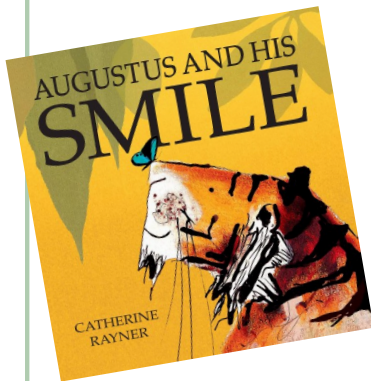
Holiday Project
