this year on the last day of term, we are planning for the children to be collected at **3.45pm** instead of 3.00pm. We hope this will give parents collecting from other schools enough time. The 3 classes will come down separately one after the other under an archway of Pashley teachers and will give us all plenty of space to properly say goodbye, give them a cheer and take any photos children and parents would like. Buzz active

The children will need to be dropped off at the **Fort Fun car park** (Fort Fun, Royal Parade, Eastbourne, East Sussex, BN22 7LU) between **9:00 and 9:15**, and collected from the same location between **15:15 and 15:30**. Children should wear comfortable, loose-fitting clothing (it may be a hot day), including a sun hat. They will need to bring a bag with them that contains:



- Swimming costume/trunks (one-piece costumes, no bikini style outfits please)
- A t-shirt that can get wet
- PE style shorts that can get wet
- Spare shoes that can get wet (water shoes or old trainers, not flip-flops or Crocs)
- Towel

Children should not bring any pocket money. Wet suits will be provided if it is a cold/rainy day. Please also ensure that you apply plenty of sun cream to your child in the morning.

The school will provide a packed lunch that has a choice of either cheese, ham or tuna rolls (please indicate your child's choice on the consent form sent earlier). If you wish to provide your own packed lunch (no glass bottles or cans please) for your child, then please tick the appropriate box on the consent form.

The cost of the Buzz active trip is £12 payable in Arbor (set-up information sent out previously).

Swimming

Swimming will count as the children's PE day this term. If you wish to do so, then please send your child in shorts and t-shirt on Fridays. This will make changing much easier for the children as opposed to tights etc.

Please send children to school with swimming gear, including a swimming cap (which are available for sale from the office at Ocklynge.) The feet of all the children are checked before they enter the pool;



children with verrucas aren't allowed to swim unless they wear a special verruca sock. Please also ensure that your children wear **no jewellery** on that day as they will not be allowed into the pool without removing it, and it may get lost! Fully trained swimming coaches will be at the pool with the children at all times. **PLEASE LET US KNOW IF YOUR CHILD HAS HAD LITTLE OR NO EXPERIENCE OF SWIMMING POOLS.**

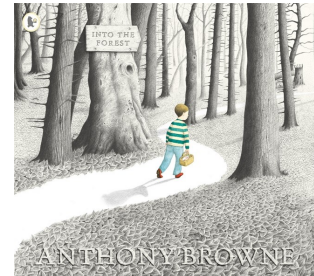
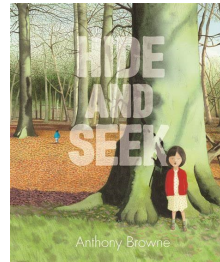


We are tackling a variety of concepts in maths including fractions, position and direction and statistics.
