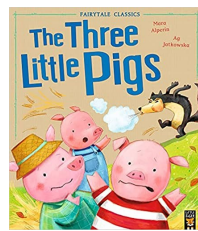
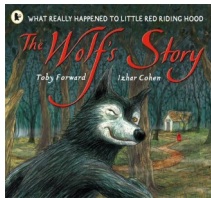
Core subjects overview:

Writing: Next term we are following our reading comprehension theme of The Three Little Pigs focusing on the art of persuasion through diary and letter writing. Children will picture themselves as the wolf and persuade their readers to trust him. Should we or shouldn't we?

Maths: It is all systems go with subtraction, addition and money next term. Children are going to be thinking about these operations using 2 digit numbers. We are rounding off the term with 3D shape.

Science: Children are going to be exploring weather patterns across the term as part of 'thinking scientifically' recording the weather each day and proving or disproving a scientific statement.
