We have now finished learning all phase 2 and 3 sounds but please continue to practice these with your child at home. We are now working on revisiting and reviewing all phase 3 sounds and using this knowledge fluently.



We have now sent all phonics cards home but if you have mislaid a few or would like some extra then please do let us know!

Please do return any school books or comics as we keep this in class sets.



Tricky words: We will be sending home some tricky word cards for the children to practice at home. Tricky words are words that can not be blending phonetically.
